## 2026 TMTA EVALUATIONS Saturday, May 9, 2026 University of Arizona

The Arizona Study Program is a twelve-year graded course of music study developed by the Arizona State Music Teachers Association to provide for the development of **repertoire**, **technique**, **and theory**. It is organized in terms of the twelve years of public school, with one level available for each of the years a student would be enrolled in school. However, a student may progress at his/her level as the teacher may deem appropriate and/or necessary. It requires continual work throughout the year. In the spring, there is a private evaluation of the repertoire and technique requirements by a Master Adjudicator, and a written theory test.

In addition to a written evaluation of their performance and a grade on their written theory test:

- Certificates and ribbons are awarded to the students to indicate their accomplishment.
- **Plaques** are awarded to those students successfully completing Elementary Division 4A and Intermediate Division 8A in Repertoire, Technique, and Theory.
- Trophies are awarded to students successfully completing the Advanced Division 12A.
- The James Anthony Award (a monetary award) is awarded to high school *seniors* who successfully complete Level 12 A.
- The Arnold Bullock Scholarship of \$400 is available to anyone who receives the James Anthony Award and then becomes a music major at a college or university. Students may apply for the scholarship by writing a letter to the ASP State Chairman stating the name of the institution you are attending, the degree being pursued, and your professional goals upon completion. Documentation must include a transcript showing 12 completed music credits.

#### **ENROLLMENT**

- 1. **Teachers must purchase a theory workbook for** *each* **student enrolled.** They are copyrighted and may not be reproduced. Proof of purchase may be requested.
- 2. Enrollments must be made online in Tenuto Web. **No refunds or substitutions.** (See *Teachers Instructions for Online Enrollment in Tenuto Web* in this Packet 1.)
- 3. Indicate previous teacher(s) of all transfer students if students previously participated in ASP.
- 4. Levels may be repeated and/or skipped at the teacher's discretion; however, a student may be evaluated in only one level per school year.
- 5. A student may be enrolled in different levels for 1) theory and 2) performance/technique\* for two years:
  - Theory must be brought up to the performance level by the third year.
  - Records will show completion of the **lower** of the two levels.
  - Indicate the different levels on all forms and name tags.
- 6. \*As of 2023-2024 ASP Evaluation year, **performance** and **technique** must be the same level.
- 7. The **performance level** will determine the time allotment for evaluation. If repertoire is longer than the time allotted, the adjudicator may not have time to hear entire piece(s).

- 8. Level 4, 8 and 12 awards are given only for successfully completing Category A. For these awards, repertoire, technique and theory must be at the same level in the same year.
- 9. A Level 12 **senior** student may take the theory test after February 1. If necessary, students can retake the test on evaluation day.
- 10. If there are any changes in level, category or enrollment, teachers may login to Tenuto Web and make changes until February 15. After that, by April 10, notify Victoria MacDonald, Tucsonasp@gmail.com

#### **Teachers' Instructions for Online Enrollment in Tenuto Web – Packet 1**

Enrollments must be submitted via Tenuto Web app no sooner than November 1<sup>st</sup>, but by December 1st (end of Early Enrollment \$35/student) or February 15 (end of Late Enrollment \$50/student).

#### Online Enrollment Instructions – Option 1 (for teachers who DID participate in ASP in 2025):

- 1. Starting no earlier than November 1<sup>st</sup>, you have the option of going directly to https://asp.tenutoweb.com. Log in using your email address and password.
- 2. Before entering your students' registrations, go to **My Students** and remove from your list (using the "unlink") students who you ARE NOT registering, "claim" former students you ARE registering, and if you are registering a student new to ASP, use the "+Add Student" and enter the student's information.
- 3. Once your **My Students** list accurately reflects the students you are registering, select Home > find your local MTA (i.e. CMTA, EVMTA, NAMTA, PMTA or TMTA) > and select Registration Forms to begin registering.

#### Online Enrollment Instructions – Option 2 (for teachers who DID NOT participate in ASP in 2025):

- 1. <u>Before beginning the Online</u> Enrollment in Tenuto Web, please check with your local ASP chairperson to make sure you have an "active" account in Tenuto Web.
- 2. Starting no earlier than November 1st, go to the <a href="www.ASMTA.org">www.ASMTA.org</a> website > select the <a href="Arizona Study Program web page">Arizona Study Program web page</a> > scroll down to the Enrollment Information section. After reading that section, select the "Click Here" link under the "Online Enrollment with Tenuto Web" on that page which takes you to "2026 ASP Online Enrollment in Tenuto Web". <a href="Follow the instructions">Follow the instructions</a> for getting your login credentials, logging in and registering students.
